The Division of Engineering Science has the following teaching assistant positions available for the 2016-2017 school year and invites applications from suitably qualified candidates.

Course Title and Description:

ESC 203 (Fall Term) -Engineering, Society and Critical Thinking

This course, taught for all year-2 Engineering Science students, examines the interrelations of engineering, society and the environment. Students will learn about and use established theoretical frameworks and models of critical thinking to explore topics including global engineering, the politicization of science and future studies. A major focus of the course is the 2-hour weekly discussion seminars, in which students participate in debates, role-play activities and other methods of discussion-based teaching to showcase the complexities in the course material.

Dates of Appointment: For Fall term courses - Immediately to 2016 to December 31, 2016

Number of Positions: 1 with hours ranging from 50-80 depending on candidate availability and schedules.

Qualifications: Applicants must have a broad spectrum of technical and non-technical interests and an interest in the intersection of science, engineering and society. Must be able to adapt and respond to unexpected classroom situations, express, argue and defend opinions to both students and instructors and demonstrate strong communication skills in oral and written forms.

Description of Duties: Assess written work and exams.
